REASONS FOR DECISION

Evidence and materials considered:

- 1. Video footage of the incident.
- 2. Red card report.
- 3. Player's submissions.

Red card upheld:

- 1. No procedural irregularity with issuing of the red card.
- 2. Foul play, which the player accepted, contrary to Law 9.13.
- 3. Red card threshold met: high degree of danger so entry point is a red card (*per* Head Contact Process ['HCP'])
- 4. No mitigation, so correct outcome is a red card (per HCP).

Sanction:

- 1. Mid-range entry point (mandated as minimum and no basis for moving to top end) 6 matches
- 2. Full mitigation for the reasons set out in player's submissions with which the FPRC agrees 50% reduction namely 3 weeks
- 3. Eligible for coaching intervention programme which FPRC approves.
