

The tournament will shine a spotlight on how a lack of body confidence is driving teenage girls and young women to drop out of sport. By celebrating strong, diverse and confident women in rugby, the tournament will inspire girls to stay in sport and give them a sense of belonging.

The Europe Summit brought together 31 Unions to promote knowledge sharing, deepen connections and inspire Unions to transform the game.



World Rugby has now been to half of its regions around the world, engaging with Unions to develop growth plans to drive forward women's and girls' rugby.



#### **PROTECTING MENTAL WELLBEING**

Through Impact Beyond 2025, World Rugby is leading the way in protecting the mental health and wellbeing of our players and match officials.

#### **Online Protection Service:**

All players, as well as Match Officials, will benefit from a ground-breaking protection service against online abuse to ensure a safe and supportive environment for all during the tournament window. The initiative will also go beyond the final whistle, with valuable insights to help us understand the trends, triggers and potential mitigations.

Female players and match officials are 30% more likely to experience online abuse

#### **Mental Health Workshops:**

In the run up to RWC 2025, World Rugby is **supporting each participating nation** to hold an in-person squad mental health workshop. Led by a trained facilitator, these sessions will **empower squads** to discuss how best to support players and staff in looking after their mental health.

#### **Peer Support Programme:**

Retired international players have been trained to **support both players and staff** at RWC 2025 who may be feeling homesick, dealing with injury, struggling with mental health or needing to talk to someone who "gets it".

Online Protection Service is it's really important because it shows exactly where you stand, to stand up and say we're actually going to make a programme to protect our match officials, players, and coaches. That's really standing up and saying, 'Yeah, nah, that's actually not cool here' while we're trying to give people the best sporting experiences of their lives.




RWC 2025 will be an era-defining moment for women's rugby. The Global Summit will harness this momentum and take bold action to create lasting change.


