REASONS FOR DECISION

The correct Law breach is Law 9.12 – striking with the elbow – not 9.11.

We assess the entry level at the Top End. We do so because of:

The deliberate actions of the Player. Striking the victim player's head (face) with his elbow;

The victim player was in a vulnerable and defenceless position on his back;

Contrary to the Player's submission we do not see any provocation by the victim player. The victim player's attempts to move the Player were legal.

There was no self-defence;

The victim player suffered an injury to his face which required stiches which is likely to leave a lifelong facial scar;

Therefore, the starting point is 10 weeks.

As to mitigation we are prepared to offer the Player the full 50% discount considering his early acceptance of breach, clean disciplinary record, his young age and inexperience and remorse.

There are no aggravating features.

Accordingly, we offer the Player an indication of sanction of 5 weeks (50% of 10 weeks = 5 weeks).

We do not consider the Player a suitable candidate for the coaching intervention programme.
