REASONS FOR DECISION			
We assess the entry level at mid-range. We do so because : • The offending (amounting to Foul Play) was reckless, that is the Player knew (or should have known) there was a risk of committing an act of Foul Play; • The action resulted in the victim Player being removed from the game (moreover, a first clinical examination indicates a suspicion of ACL rupture, with the victim player being ruled out for the remainder of the competition); and • The Player initially wrapped the victim Player with a twisting movement (croc roll) and fell to the side, as admitted. However, it is also correctly acknowledged that Wales 18 pushed the Player from behind, adding significant pressure and weight onto the victim player's left knee. Therefore, the mid-range starting point is 6 weeks. As to mitigation we are prepared to offer the Player the full 50% discount considering his early acceptance of breach, clean disciplinary record, his young age, inexperience and remorse. There are no aggravating factors. Accordingly, we offer the Player an indication of sanction of 3 weeks (50% of 6 weeks = 3 weeks).
